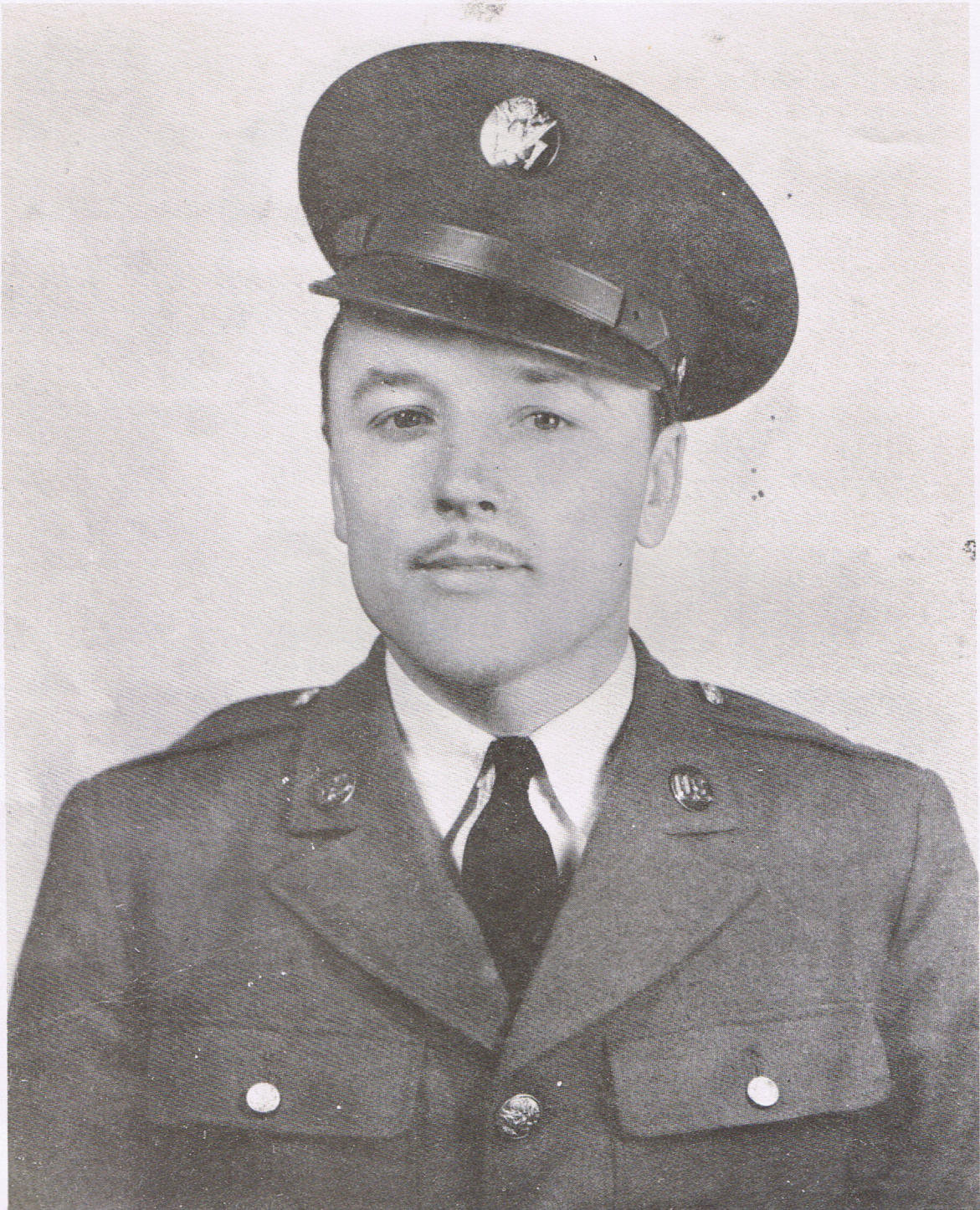


Capt. Albert Mitchell "In Flanders Field"

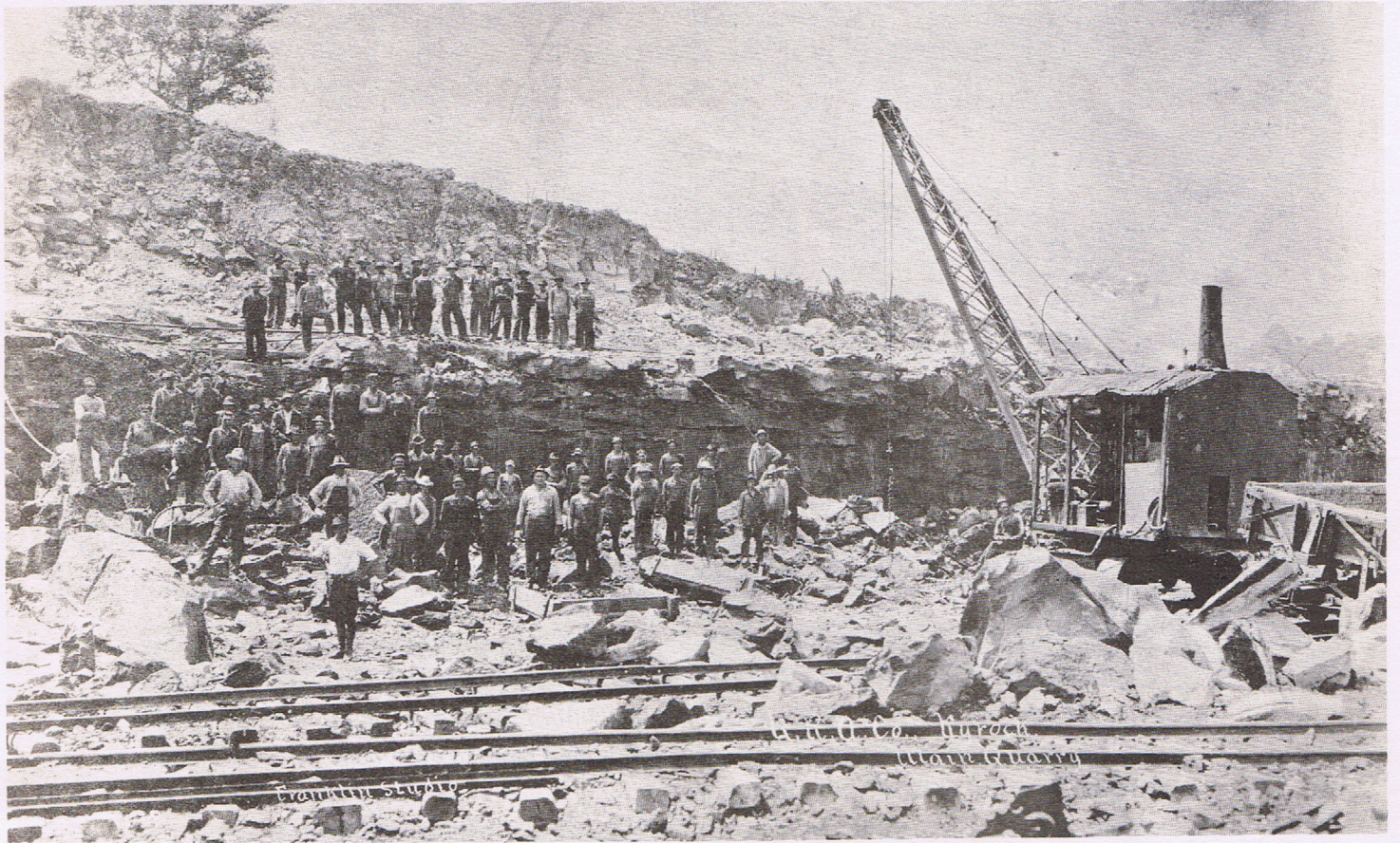
They were here another day, this place no more to see,

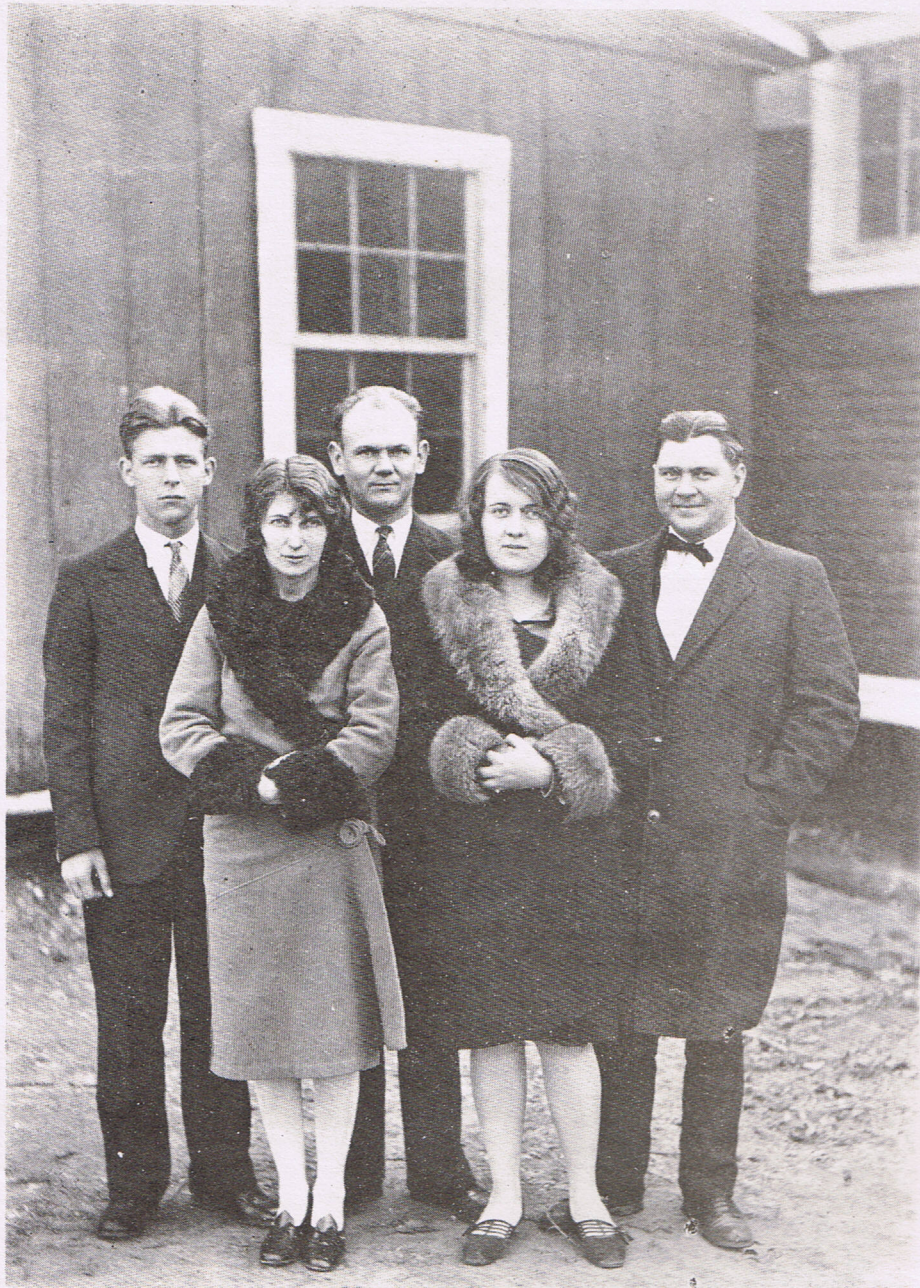

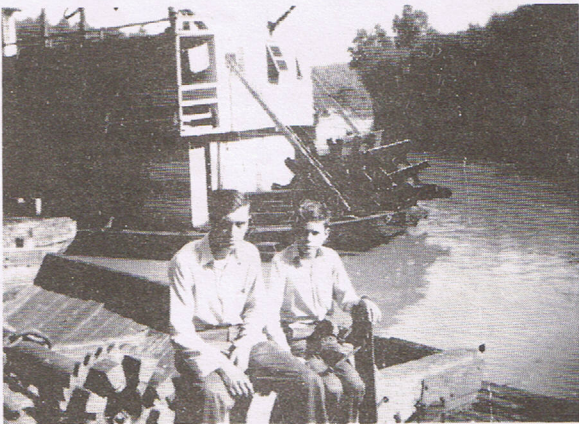

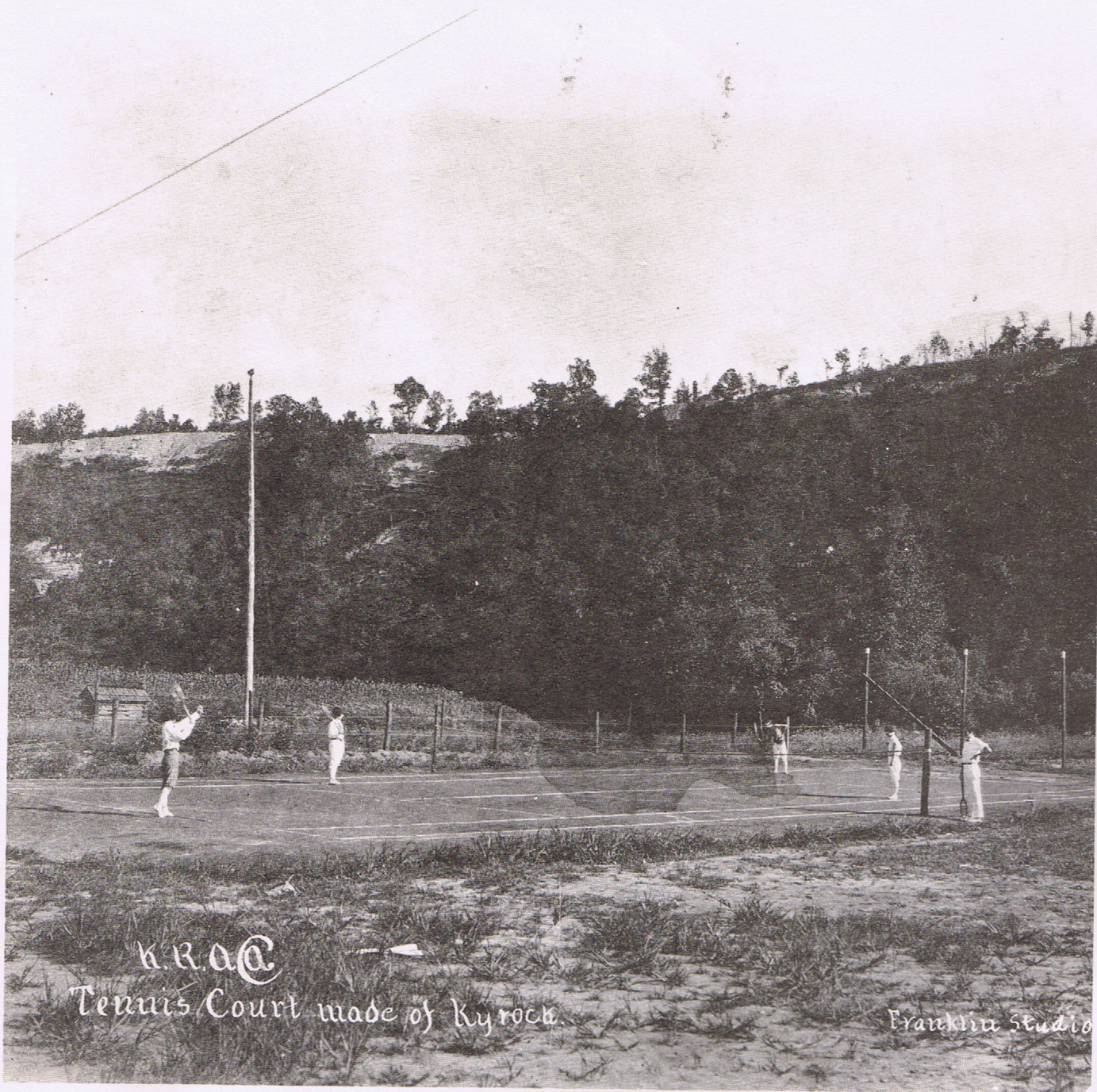
